All employers have a duty to prepare, maintain and implement a traffic management plan (TMP) should workers or patrons at an event be exposed to the road network or traffic. The types of events that may require written transport and traffic management plans may include special events, recreation/sporting events, music festivals and outdoor concerts.

The transport and traffic management plan (TMP) should be based on a practical assessment of the risks associated with the work activity, workplace or event, and consider the possible consequences of an emergency occurring as a result of those hazards. All employers have a duty in the WHS Act & Regulations 2011 to prepare, maintain and implement an emergency plan that provides for the following:

- emergency procedures
- an effective response to an emergency
- evacuation procedures
- notifying emergency services
- medical treatment and assistance
- effective communication on the plans with all workers at the workplace
- testing of the emergency procedures
- information, training and instruction to relevant workers in relation to implementing the emergency procedures.

The types of emergencies to plan for may include fire, explosion, medical emergency, rescues, and incidents with hazardous chemicals, bomb threats, armed confrontations and natural disasters.

The emergency plan should be based on a practical assessment of hazards associated with the event or workplace, and the possible consequences of an emergency occurring as a result of those hazards. Avert Risk Management services can assist clients at all stages of the Emergency Management process in accordance with the WHS Act & Regulations 2011 and the process defined within the Australian Standard AS/NZS 3745:2010 - Planning for emergencies in facilities.
